WHAT TO BRING

To help you get ready to move into your new home, we've created a guide outlining what is included in the rooms, what you can bring and prohibited items.

WHAT TO BRING

This is not an extensive list! Please remember that residence hall living spaces have limited space and come fully furnished.

ROOM/PERSONAL

- Bedding (twin-XL): sheets, blanket/bedspread, pillow
- Floor or desk lamp (non-halogen)
- Desk and school supplies
- Metal wastebasket
- Clothing for all seasons and hangers
- Towels, bathrobe, shower shoes, toiletries
- Laundry detergent
- General cleaning supplies: broom, mop, cleaning wipes, etc.
- Power strip/surge protected electrical cords

BATHROOM

- Shower curtain
- Toilet paper
- Plunger
- Bathroom cleaning supplies

KITCHEN

- Pots, pans, dishes, utensils
- Dish soap, sponges
- Cooking Appliances
- Microwave

Cooking appliances are only allowed in kitchen spaces.

OPTIONAL ITEMS

- Microwave (less than 700 watts) - 1 per bedroom; no more than 1 per suite/apartment
- Refrigerator (4.0 cubic feet or less)- 1 per bedroom
- Electronics- TV, tablet, gaming console
- Photos and decorations
- Painter's Tape- least likely to damage paint
- Mirror
- Flashlight
- Single serve Keurig

WHAT'S INCLUDED...

IN EACH ROOM

- Twin XL bed
- Desk
- Desk Chair
- Dresser
- Wardrobe/Closet

IN SUITES

- Bathroom*

IN APARTMENTS

- Full refrigerator
- Stove/oven
- Bathroom*
- Furnished living room/dining area

IN ST. JULIE HALL APARTMENTS

- Dishwasher
- Washer/Dryer

St. Julie Hall does NOT have overhead lighting inside bedrooms.

*Students with in-unit bathrooms are responsible for bathroom cleanliness.

WHAT **NOT** TO BRING

Our office works closely with Facilities and local authorities to maintain a safe living environment. Below is a list of prohibited items, not allowed in our residence halls.

LISTED ALPHABETICALLY

- Alcohol or Illegal drugs
- Alcohol/Drug/Smoking paraphernalia-empty bottles, shot glasses, hookahs, bong, grinders, etc.
- Candles/incense (with or without wick)
- Cinderblocks (plastic bed risers are allowed)
- Cooking Appliances: Sandwich maker/George Foreman grill, toasters, hot plates, electric tea pots, coffee makers, rice cookers, etc. (FENNELL AND TREEHOUSE ONLY)
- Dart boards
- Decorative lights including string lights
- Firearms/weapons of any kind(including pepper spray)
- Fireworks/explosives
- Furniture: upholstered couches/sofas, futons, ottomans etc.
- Lava lamps, halogen lamps, and neon signs
- Martial arts equipment
- Nails, screws or tacks for walls
- Non-UL approved extension cords or octopus outlets
- Paint (rooms may not be painted)
- Pets
- Space heaters, heat lamps, and air conditioner units
- Sub woofers/large base units
- Large Tapestries or curtains/window treatments (walls may not be more than 1/3 covered; no items may be placed on ceilings)
- Water beds
- Wireless Printers
- For a full list of items prohibited on campus check the Student Handbook and Housing Contract

Our office can not provide room dimensions or measurements for specific furniture as spaces vary. Our furniture is standard to what can be found in most residence halls.

RESIDENCE HALL ADDRESSES

You may order items to arrive to campus *after* you have arrived. Our mailrooms have limited space! We encourage the use of our local City Target and Bed Bath and Beyond, right in the Fenway Area, both of which allow pre-order and pick up.
