- 1. **An essay** of approximately 400 words explaining a concrete example of a question or a topic that puzzled or fascinated you and how you went about learning more about it. For example, you might have thought about the moon illusion; that is, the moon appears larger on the horizon than it does when high in the night sky. Why did the observation interest you? How did you satisfy your curiosity? The Honors Program looks for talented students who have a strong sense of intellectual curiosity. Demonstrate your curiosity and your strategy for finding answers.
- 2. **A separate essay** of 400 words describing an ethical, social/political, or scientific problem of great importance to you. How would you potentially explore this issue as part of your research in the Honors program, and how would you start to gather information to help deepen your understanding of the topic? Be as specific as possible.
- 3. A Curriculum Vitae
- 4. An **example of a research project** you have done in your first three semesters at MCPHS University with this application. This research sample could be a multi-source synthesis essay, a multi-source, synthetic poster project or an outside research project that you believe demonstrates your ability to undertake and complete research work.
