Public Notice of Upcoming CCNE Accreditation Review

January 15, 2026

The Massachusetts College of Pharmacy and Health Sciences (MCPHS) School of Nursing will host a Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE) accreditation site visit on March 23-25, 2026. This visit is part of the process for reaccreditation of our MSN and Certificate of Advanced Graduate Studies (CAGS) programs, and the respective tracks (AD to MSN, MSN-FNP, MSN-PMHNP, CAGS-FNP and CAGS-PMHNP).

Prior to the accreditation visit, schools of nursing are required to provide an opportunity for various stakeholders and communities of interest to provide third-party comments directly to CCNE. Written and signed third-party comments will be accepted by CCNE up to 21 days before the scheduled visit (March 2, 2026, deadline).

Only signed comments are accepted by CCNE. CCNE shares third-party comments with members of the evaluation team before the visit, but at no time during the review process are these comments shared with the program. During its review of the program, the evaluation team considers third-party comments that relate to the accreditation standards. All third-party comments submitted to CCNE must be written in English, consistent with CCNE's policy on Conduct of Business in English.
