There are no options via the publisher to get a non-Kindle electronic copy of the book, so students who don't want to/can't pay for the book would have these options:

- Download from Ebook Central and read the pdf on their laptop
- Download Adobe Digital Editions to their phone and read the downloaded E-Book Central pdf with it
- Read the book online on their phone or laptop via E-Book Central
- Check their local public library for a print or electronic copy
- Check out a print reserve copy from their campus library
- *Users may also change the settings in their ProQuest account to turn on Accessibility mode (also known as Text-only mode) if they want to use a screenreader with the pdf. They would still need to use one of the first three options listed above to access the book. This part only affects how they “read” the content they have accessed.
