These e-books do <u>not</u> include PDF versions from a publish or Kindle/EPub formats. Whenever possible, we will purchase unlimited simultaneous users; however, this option is not always available. We are automatically notified each time someone is not able to access an e-book. If we see a pattern, we will purchase more copies. Print copies will be provided whenever an e-book is not available.

We would also appreciate a notification of any films that you plan to use during the semester, even if you used them recently. Streaming video is always leased by the year. We want to be sure that access is available when you want to show or assign the film.
