Medical terminology, students must receive a minimum grade of a 80% or better in order to meet the requirements of the curriculum and progress on to the following semester

GU/GYN exam, students must participate in order to meet the requirements of the curriculum and progress to the clinical year

Comprehensive PE, students must receive a minimum grade of a 73% or better in order to complete the requirements of the curriculum and progress to the clinical year

ACLS training, students are required to complete ACLS training during the first year in order to progress to the clinical year. ACLS proof of certification required by the first day of Fall semester

PACKRAT exam, students must participate in the practice exam in order to meet the requirements of the curriculum and to be considered program complete

Summative exam/OSCEs, students must receive a minimum grade of a C or better in order to complete the requirements of the curriculum and be considered program complete

Clinical Year Procedures and Technical Skills Passport, student must complete the procedures in order to meet the requirements of the curriculum and be considered program complete

Each didactic year course of the program requires a minimum grade of a 73% or better in order to progress to the next semester.

Each clinical year course of the program requires a minimum grade of a 73% or better in order to progress to the next semester.

Each semester of the program requires a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better in order to progress to the next semester.

Each program didactic year course, clinical year rotation course and curricular components requires successful completion in order to be program complete
