PACKRAT exam, students must participate in the practice exam in order to meet the requirements of the curriculum and to be considered program complete
EOCE/OSCEs, students must receive a minimum grade of a 73% or better in order to complete the requirements of the curriculum and be considered program complete
Clinical Year Procedures and Technical Skills Passport, student must complete the procedures in order to meet the requirements of the curriculum and be considered program complete
