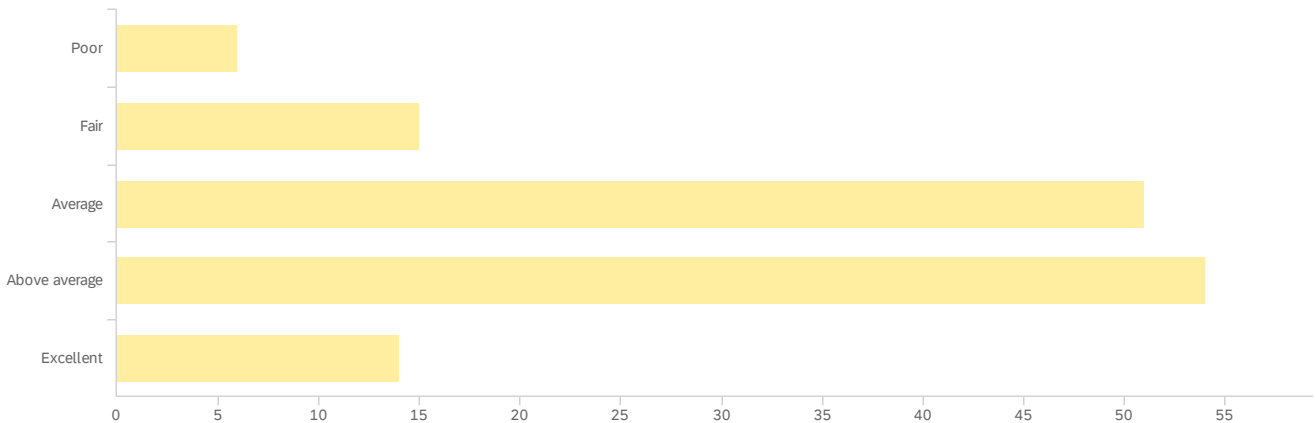

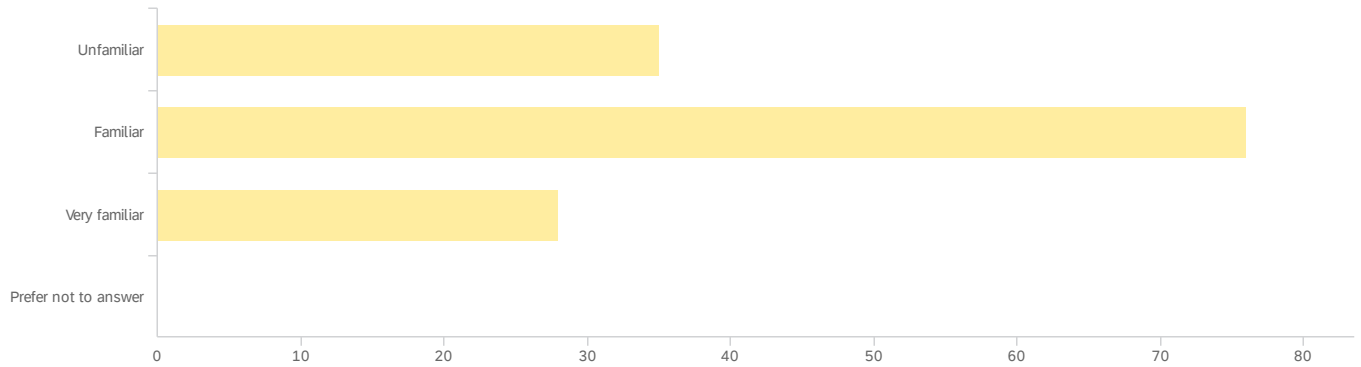

How familiar are you with the MCPHS Title IX Policy on sexual harassment, including sexual assault, stalking, domestic and dating violence?

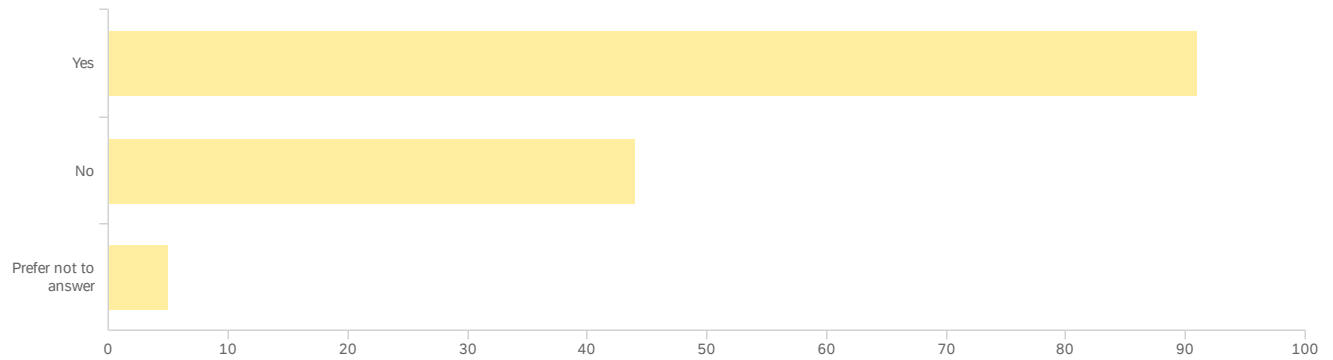

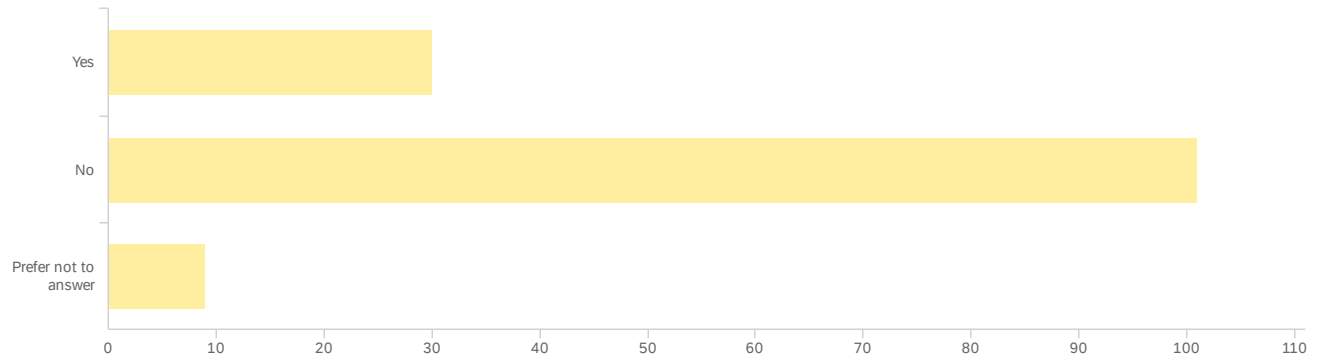

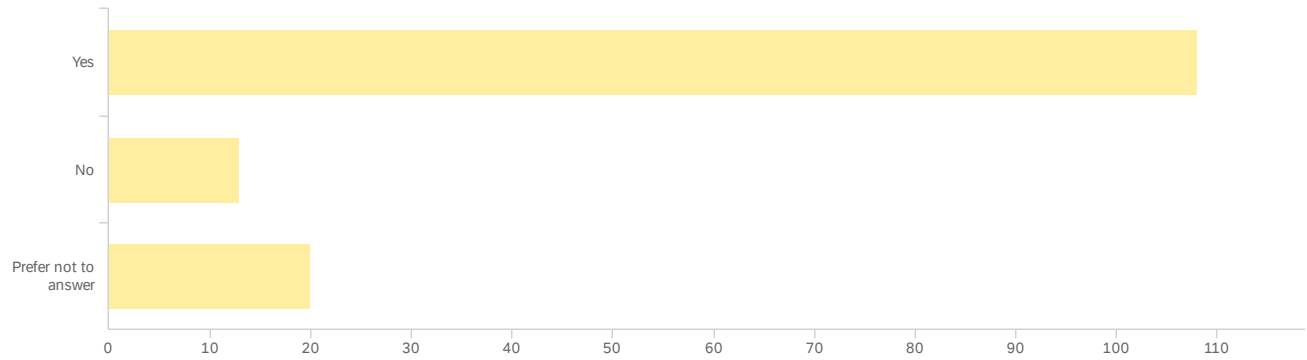

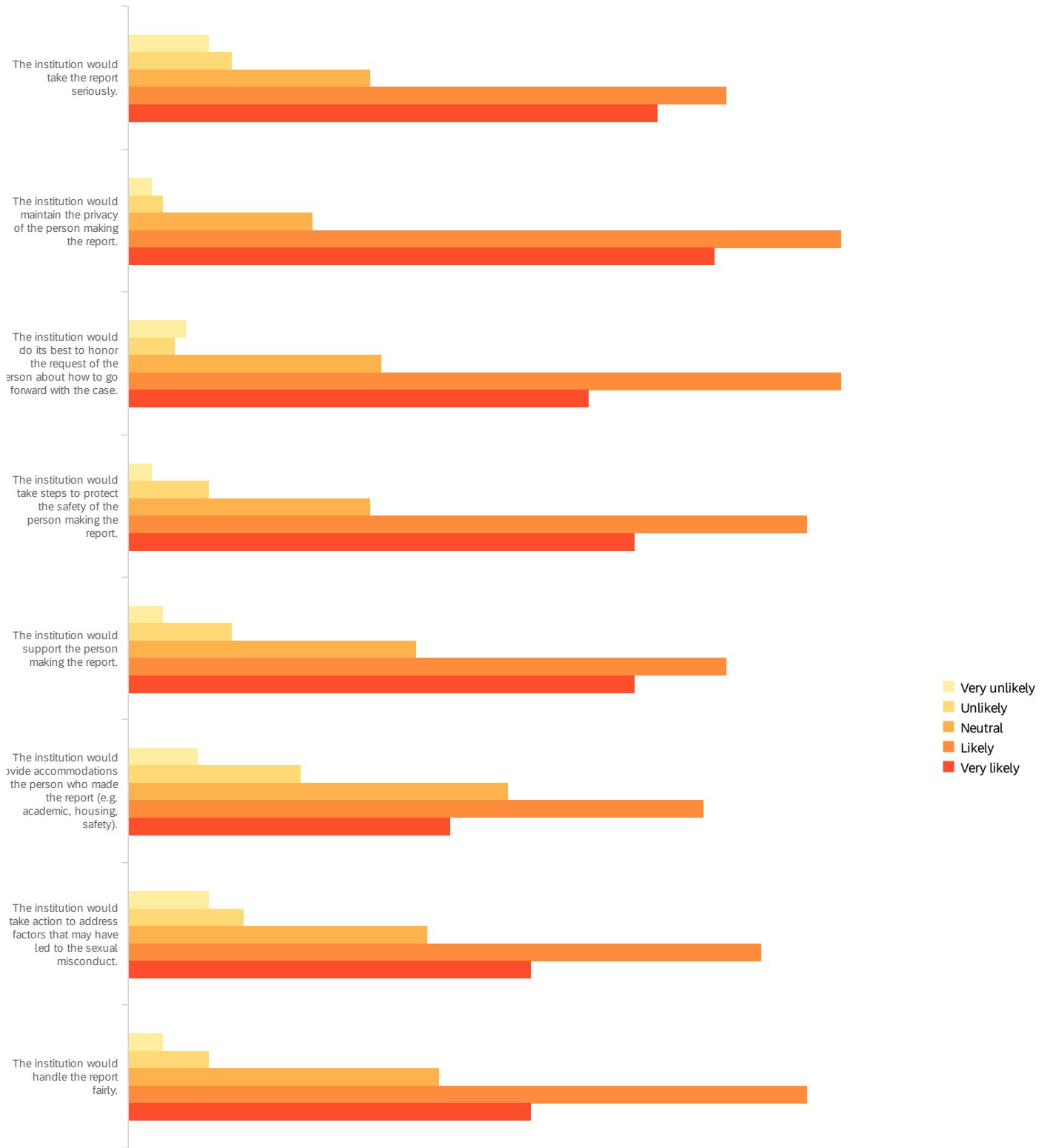
If you were the victim of sexual harassment, including sexual assault, stalking, domestic or dating violence, would you bring forward a report to MCPHS?

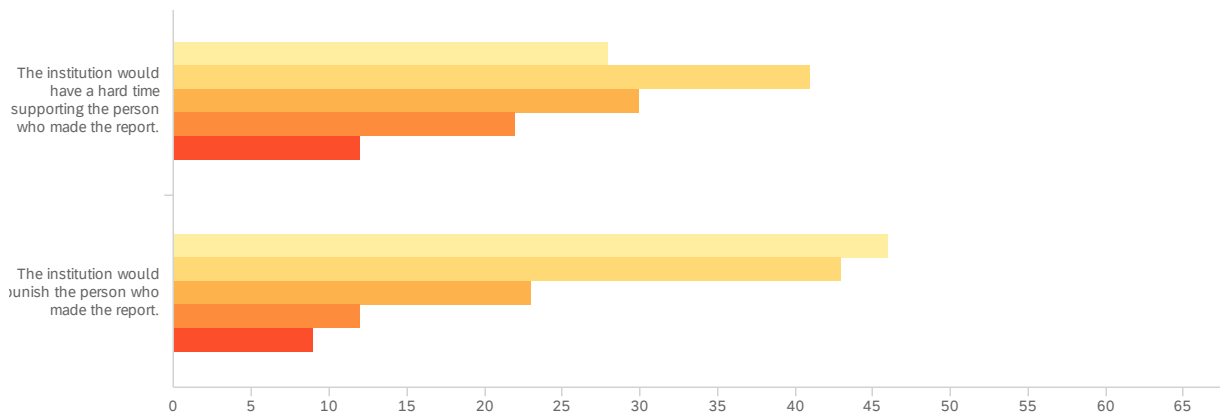

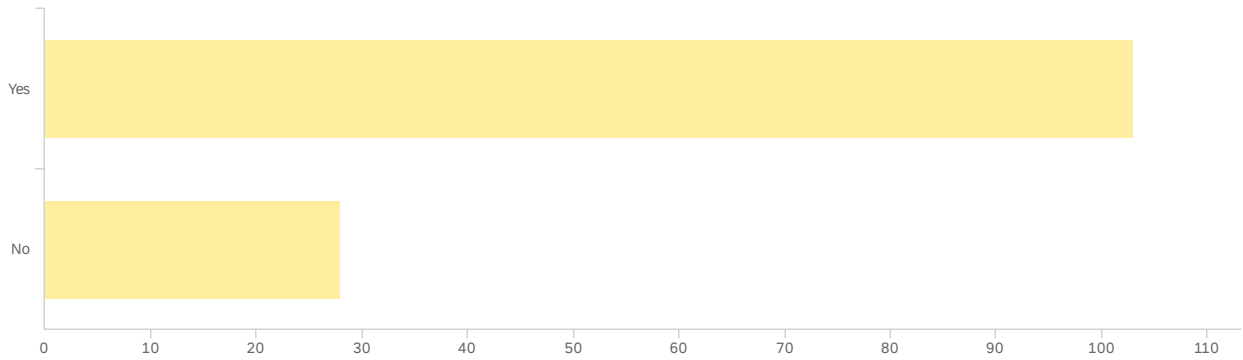

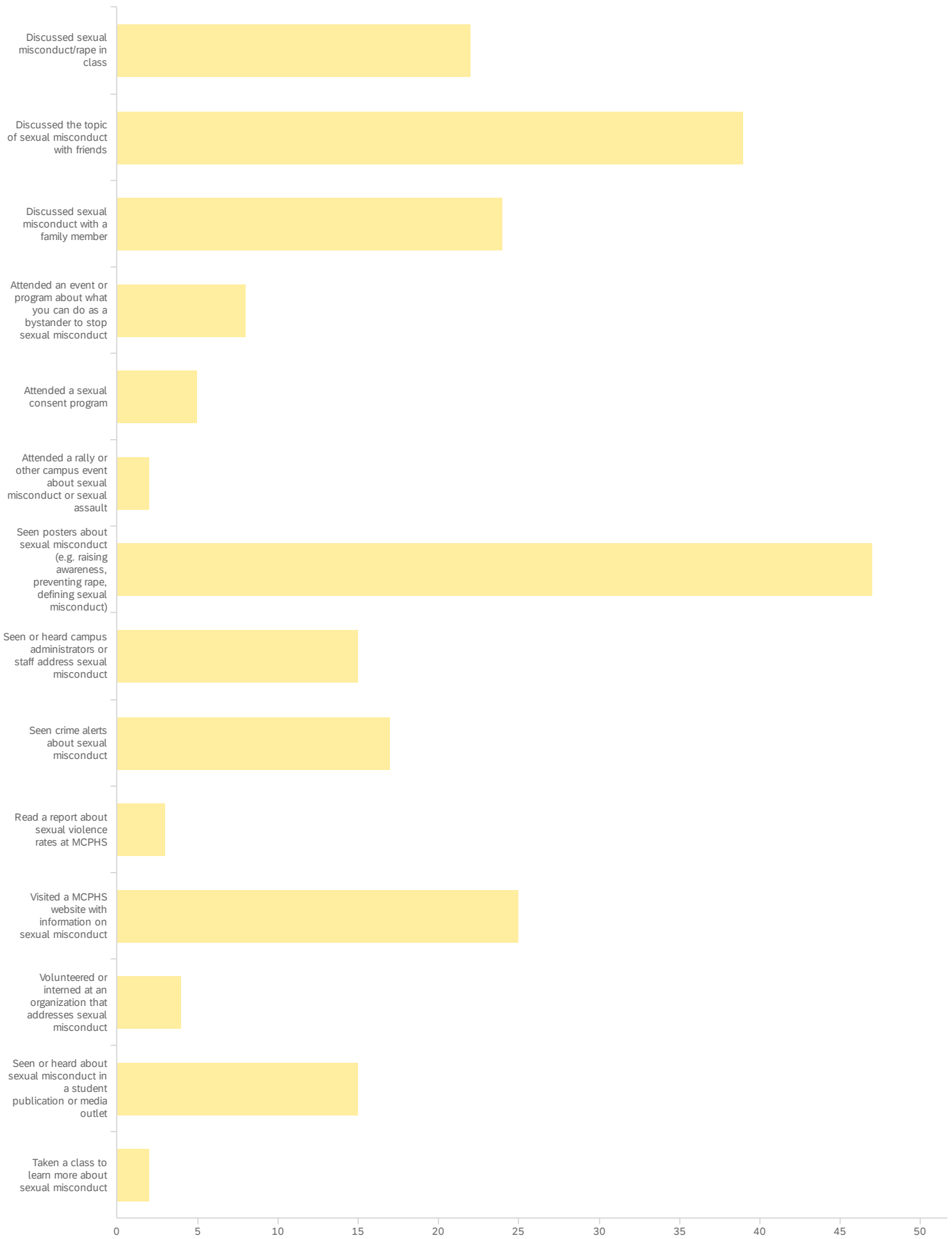

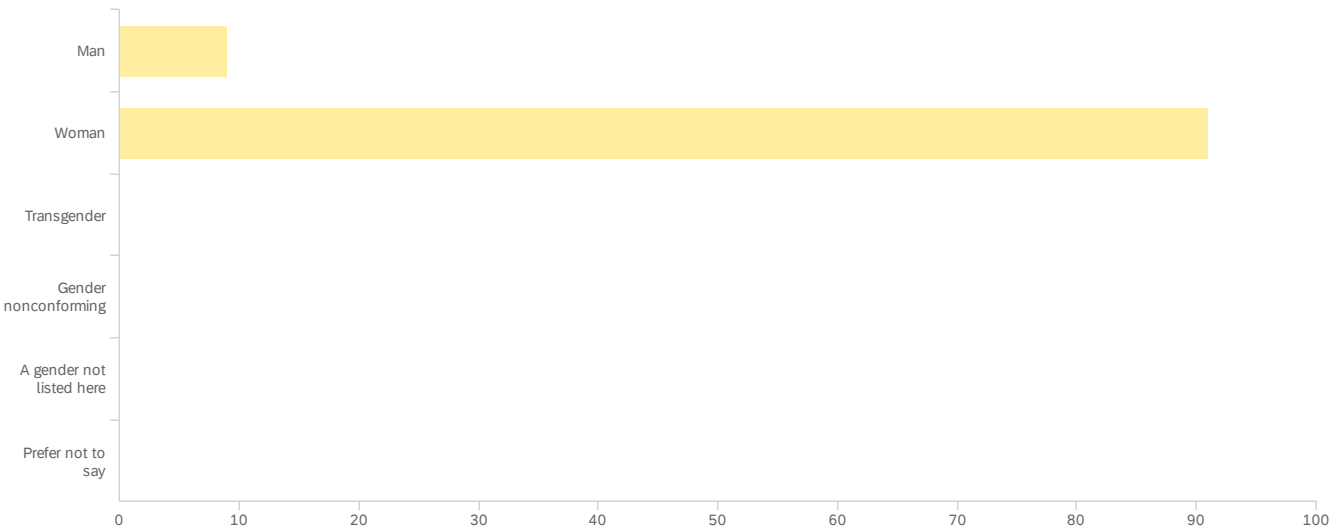

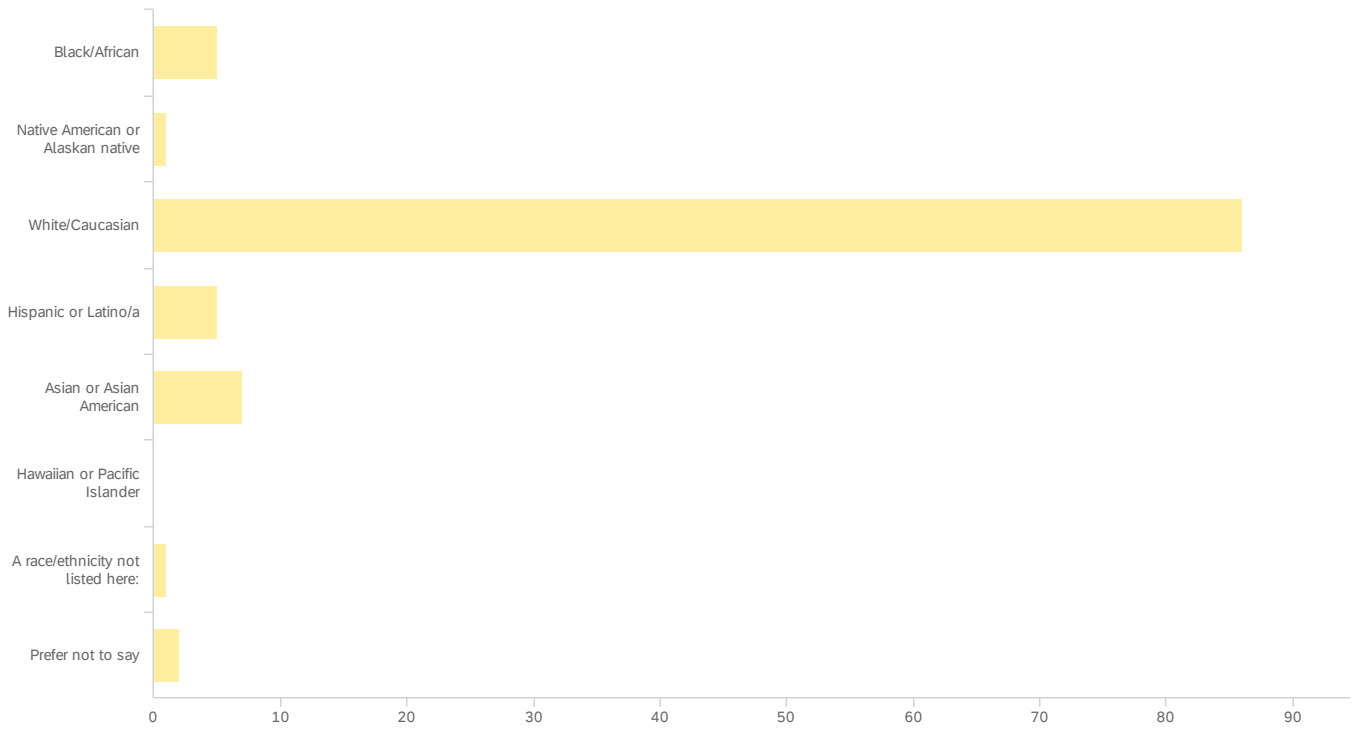
# What is your age?



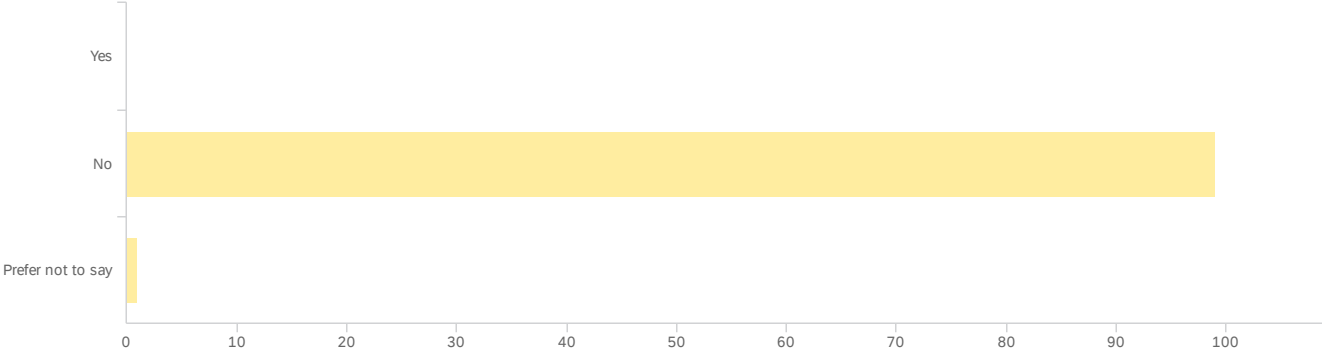
# What best describes your gender identity?

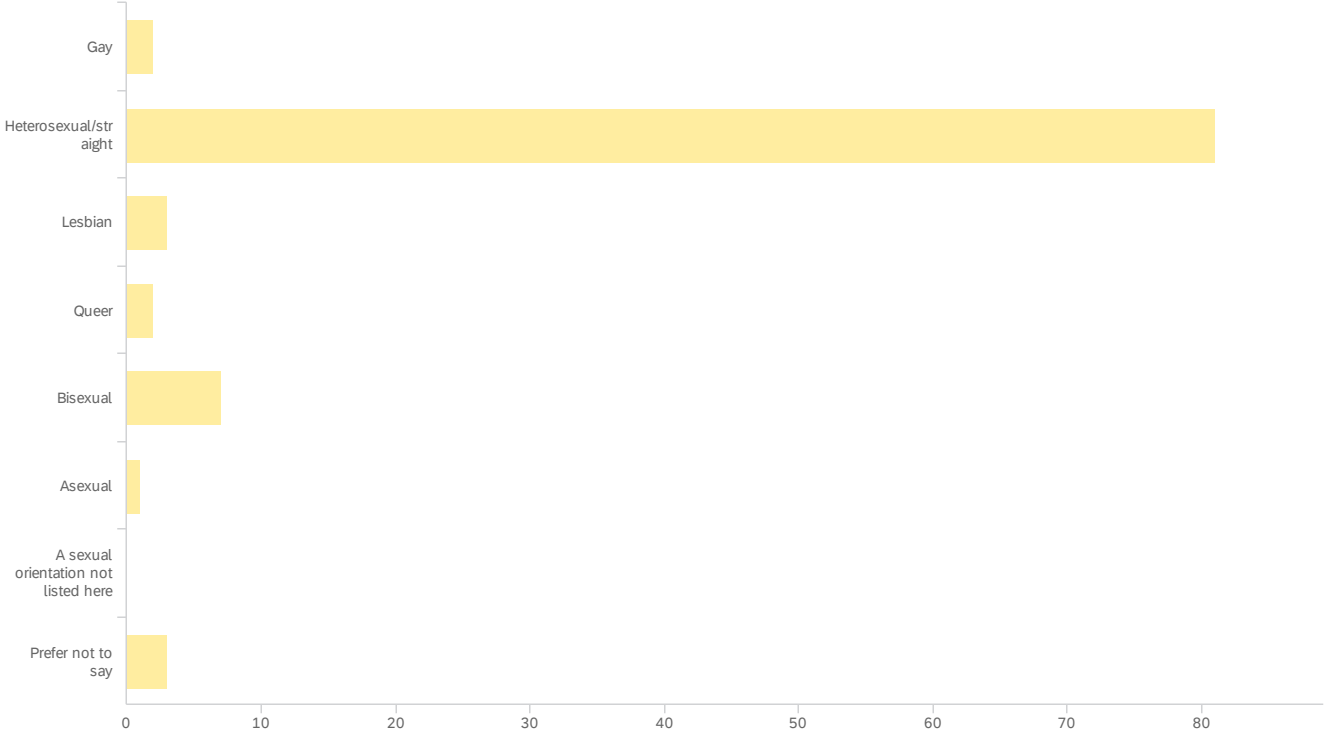

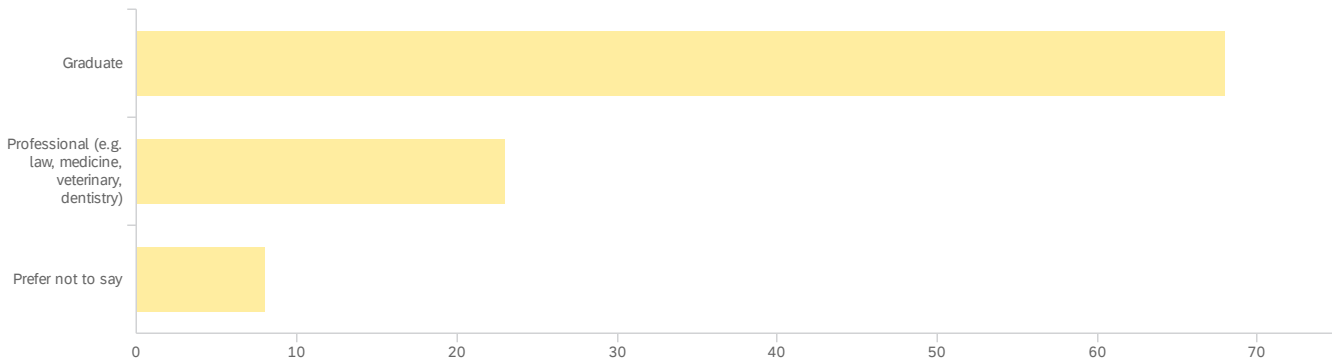




# What is your sexual orientation?

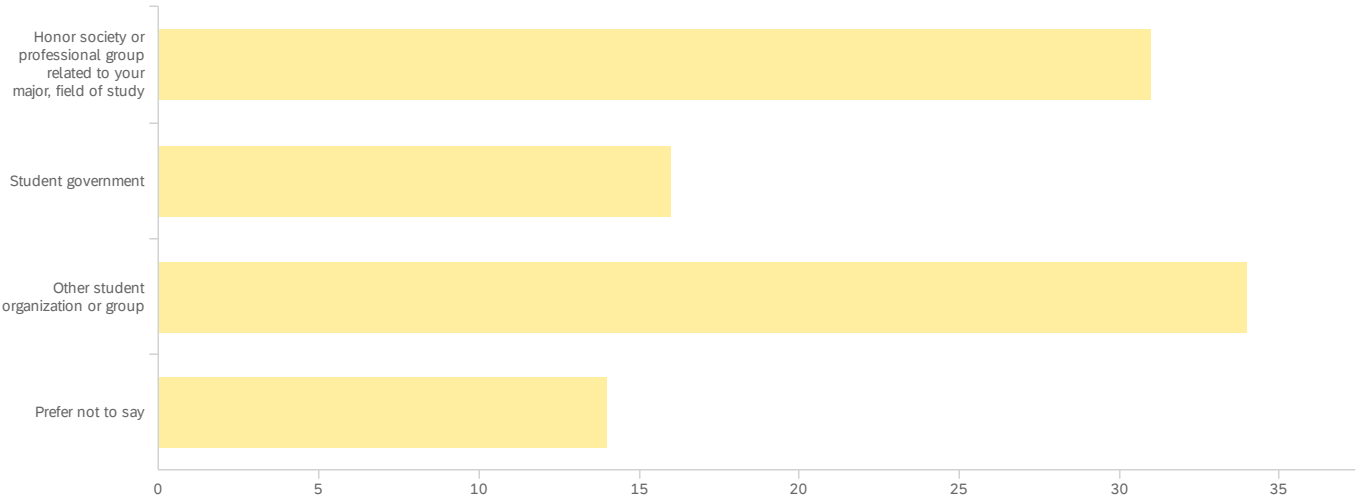


# What year of school are you in?
